Why promoting repair?





65% of consumers currently choose to replace goods instead of repairing them



Discarded goods create unnecessary waste of 7.4 million tons per year in the EU



10.5 million tons per year of **valuable resources** used to produce new goods

Promoting repair within the legal guarantee

Legal guarantee for defects existing on delivery



Delivery



2 years

REPAIR

OR

REPLACE







Sellers will have to repair, if it is cheaper or as costly as replacement



European Repair Information Form Obligation to repair & inform



European Repair Information Form

Obligation to repair & inform



European Repair Information Form

Right to request the form from any repairer

Conditions remain valid for 30 days

Standardised information on repair conditions






European Repair Information Form

Obligation to repair & inform



Producer's obligation to repair



Producers of goods subject to repairability requirements (eco-design)

Obligation to repair goods (e.g. washing machines, dishwashers, *smartphones, tablets*)

Obligation to inform consumers about repair & provide the European Repair Information Form





To the extent and for the duration set out by eco-design requirements


